Shihan Takeji Ogawa sa narodil 24. novembra v roku 1942 v Chiba (Japonsko). Karate sa začal venovať už ako sedemročný.

Prišiel do Rakúska v roku 1970 na podporu japonského karate, kde sa aj oženil a mal tri deti.

Väčšinu roka je v zahraničí. Vyučuje a pomáha Goju-Ryu Karate praktiky. Od 1985 do 1992 bol trénerom národného tímu Rakúska.

Shihan Take Ogawa je zakladateľom Goju-Ryu v Rakúsku a aj na Slovensku. Pravidelne učí Goju-Ryu Karate v krajinách ako je Rakúsko, Nemecko, Švajčiarsko, Chorvátsko, Rusko, Česká republika, Slovensko a Maďarsko. On je

Shihan Takeji Ogawa was born on November 24th, 1942 in Chiba, Japan. His passion for karate began at the age of seven.

Shihan arrived in Austria in 1970 to promote Japanese karate. He would go on to marry and have three children there.

He spends most of his year abroad, teaching and helping Goju-Ryu practitioners. Between 1985 and 1992, Shihan acted as the Austrian National Team Coach.

Shihan TAKEJI OGAWA was his trainer during national representation is the founder of Goju-Ryu in both Austria and Slovakia, and, as its main instructor, he regularly trains Goju-Ryu Karate in

V roku 1970 som prišiel do Viedne na športovú školu ako tréner na dvojročnú zmluvu, následne ma príležitosť zaviedla do Bratislavy, kde som na Slovensku začínal. Prirodzene v tom čase bol na Slovensku socializmus, prísne kontroly a strážené hranice, vtedy pre mňa nezvyklé v porovnaní s demokratickým Japonskom. Našiel som tu ale aj priateľských ľudí. Takto to vtedy bolo, úprimne povedané.

Začal som ľudí vyučovať, ale ľudia sa vyvíjali aj sami tvrdým tréningom a preto dosahovali také úspechy.

Ja som im len dával rady. Ľudia sa usilovným tréningom vyvíjali ďalej, čo je pre karate veľmi dôležité.

Tento spoločný tréning je pre mňa veľmi pekná spomienka. Tvrdo sme trénovali ale aj zábavne. Mám radosť tu opäť byť a spoločne trénovať.

Áno, v roku 2006, presný dátum som už zabudol, bol som sem pozvaný a takisto som bol súčasne aj v klube v Považskej Bystrici.

Karate je teraz väčšinou ponímané ako šport. V tomto športe je Slovensko veľmi úspešné.

Moji žiaci sa vyvíjali ako aj terajší prezident, Dano Liška. Slovenské

I arrived in Vienna in 1970 under a two-year contract to work as a karate trainer at the Vienna sport school. The opportunity brought me to Bratislava where I also started my activities. Slovakia was under the socialist system at that time, including tough border checks and a guarded border. That was quite unusual for me as I came from a democratic Japan. I met friendly people in Slovakia. That is how it was at that time.

I started teaching people, but they also developed on their own through tough trainings and that is why they were so successful.

I only gave them pieces of advice. People worked hard in their training and kept developing, something that is very important for karate.

That joint training brings back very fond memories. The trainings were hard work but there was fun as well. I was very happy to be here again to conduct a joint training; yes it was in 2006 but I cannot remember the exact date. I was invited here and I also trained at the Považska Bystrica club.

Karate is now usually well-perceived as a sport. Slovakia is very successful when it comes to this sport.

My students developed just like the current president, Dano Liška.

Mám dobré spomienky. Zase som stretol veľa ľudí, ktorých som dlho nevidel a spolu sme si zatreňovali. Som z toho šťastný.

Tento rok mám 70 rokov, pre mňa to nie je nič mimoriadne. Či mám 70, 71 alebo 72 ... pre mňa to je život. Ja nepotrebujem žiadne veľké oslavy. Chcem sa ďalej vyvíjať. Karate je môj život.

Áno, chcem sa ďalej vyvíjať a plniť si svoje sny. Chcem byť pripravený. Ešte ako dlho, to neviem. Ale budem sa snažiť a trénovať.

Mladí ľudia sa venujú športovému karate. Ale dôležité je aj karate DO. DO je niečo ako férovosť.

Duchovná stránka je tiež dôležitá, nie byť stále arogantným. To je karate DO.

Moje spomienky sú takéto: Tvrdo sme s mladými ľuďmi trénovali, ale sme sa aj bavili. Veľmi pekné spomienky.

Slovak karate is at a high level – it has a European champion and a world champion. I did not conduct many training directly; I just gave advice. People were improving through hard work, their own independent training. Their success is not my merit; it is above all the merit of Slovak trainers.

I have good memories. I again met many people who I have not seen for years. We had practiced together. That makes me happy.

I am 70 this year. That is nothing extraordinary to me. Whether I am 70, 71 or 72 ... that is life. I do not need big parties. I want to keep developing. Karate is my life. Yes, I want to keep developing and making my dreams come true. I want to be prepared. How much longer, I really do not know. But I will work hard and train.

Young people engage in the sport of karate. The DO of karate is also important. DO is something like being fair.

The spiritual aspect also is important – not being arrogant. That is what DO karate means.

My memories are that we trained hard with young people but we also had a lot of fun. Very nice memories.



Miloš Smejkal

Mr. Ogawa represents forty years of our lives to us. We always learned from him, and would like to keep learning. They achieved results. In the former Czechoslovak Republic, they were national champions multiple times, as well as European and world champions.

Twenty years ago, when the system of training of police and special forces within the police departments of Slovakia was being put together, we incorporated certain self-defense aspects that came directly from karate.

Pavol Dubček

I want to take this opportunity to thank Mr. Ogawa who was not only our teacher, but also our friend. And to all our friends, I would like to wish plenty of health, so that we could have the chance to meet after many more years. Everyone trains as God allows them to, and I'm happy that they are all here.

Not everyone is brought to these meetings through just sport, but also by a reanimation of the spirit.

Jaroslav Juhás

He trained us for many years, and after forty we discovered that without him, Slovakian karate did not advance nearly as much as in the past. To us, he was more than a Japanese karate master, who sacrificially began training us Japanese karate with dedication.

Daniel Liška

I think we were incredibly lucky that Master Ogawa arrived because he is a significant personality and he has an air of friendship to him, as well as being a very good teacher.

Písal sa rok 1972. Znamenal začiatok slovenského karate, keďže bol založený zväz v Československu. V tomto roku som začal trénovať na vysokoškolskom internáte "Bernolák". Mojimi trénermi boli: Jozef Šimkovič (USA, s ktorým sme založili v roku 1977 oddiel TJ SPOJE BRATISLAVA), Martin Mikuš, Vlado Kubovčík, Lubo Cisár a aj Tibor Mikuš (TJ Slávia SVŠT).

Týždenník ŠTART priniesol titulku z karate, na ktorej bol Palo Dubček s Martinom Mikušom na hrade Devín. Za túto fotku bol fotoreportér Jaro Zelený následne vyhodnený z redakcie (robil už len šoféra do dôchodkového veku v nemenovanom podniku). Na fotografii bol totiž Palo Dubček, syn Alexandra Dubčeka (Palo mal zakázané zúčastňovať sa súťaží ako športovec a aj ako lekár).

Oddiel TJ Spoje Bratislava vznikol v roku 1977. Pod vedením Jozefa Šimkoviča (USA) a Jozefa Mýtného vyrástli mnohí reprezentanti. (Igor Debrecký viacnásobný ME, Ján Dado, Libor Bučka, Juraj Farkaš, Emil Kocian, Milan Navara, Štefan Bielik...)

1980 príprava na ME v Barcelone, tréning s Takeji Ogawom, našim reprezentačným trénerom. Zápasil som pozvoľna s Lacom Klementisom, dal som ho na podlahu s ashi barai, spadol ako "hnilá hruška" v zápase

MEMORIES OF JOZEF MÝTNY

The beginnings of karate in Slovakia were marked in 1972 with the establishment of the karate association of Czechoslovakia. I started training at the university dormitory called "Bernolák" under the supervision of coaches Jozef Šimkovič (USA, with whom we started the TJ SPOJE BRATISLAVA karate club in 1977), Martin Mikuš, Vlado Kubovčík and Lubo Cisár as well as Tibor Mikuš (TJ Slávia SVŠT).

The ŠTART weekly published a photo on karate showing Palo Dubček and Martin Mikuš at Devín Castle. The photojournalist, Jaro Zelený, was expelled from his job with the magazine as a result (he then worked as a driver for an unnamed enterprise until his retirement). The reason was that the photo included Palo Dubček, the son of Alexander Dubček. Palo Dubček was banned from participating in competitions as an athlete or as a physician.

The club TJ Spoje Bratislava was established in 1977. Many athletes developed into national representatives under the guidance of Jozef Šimkovič (USA) and Jozef Mýtny: people such as Igor Debrecký, a multiple European champion, Ján Dado, Libor Bučka, Juraj Farkaš, Emil Kocian, Milan Navara, Štefan Bielik and others.

Preparations for the Barcelona European Championship under the supervision of Takeji Ogawa took place in 1980. I was in competition with Laco Klementis and brought him down with an ashi barai: he landed on the floor like a "sack of potatoes" which meant a clear IPPON. What Laco did

V roku 1980 na Majstrovstvách Československa v Prahe bral oddiel TJ SPOJE BRATISLAVA z 25 medailí 16. Mali sme výnimočných pretekárov, ale čo sa dialo “v zákulisi?” František Šebej ako hlavný rozhodca majstrovstiev nemal právo podľa stanov rozhodovať v zápasišti, len koordinovať rozhodcov...ale...ked’ som nastupoval na finálový zápas s Lacom Klementisom (jeho kamarátom) odstrčil rozhodcu v zápasišti a šiel rozhodovať tento zápas. Prečo? ... lebo potreboval dať vyhrať kamarátovi. A tento František Šebej sedí teraz v parlamente SR? ... a ešte predtým v Barcelone 1980 na ME bol aj s Petrom Vavrom manažérom Československej reprezentácie a v ich povinnostiach bolo aj budiť pretekárov ráno o 7 hod. Ja konkrétne som mal zápasiť v nedeľu, ale nezobudili ma... Prečo - spýtal som sa ho?...”No boli sme s brnenskými baletkami do ranných hodín,” povedal František Šebej (čítaj meno zozadu). ČO VIAC DODAŤ...

Rok 1982, Československá liga. Družstvo TJ SPOJE Bratislava nastupuje proti TJ Ekonóm Bratislava o postup medzi prvú päťku, rozhoduje Tibor Mikuš, ktorému niečo našepkáva Ladislav Klementis. Po tom si ma zavolať Tibor Mikuš, ako kapitána TJ SPOJE a prikazuje

right then was an unfair blow; he attacked me from my back side and smashed my mouth. I asked “Laco, what do you think you ...” and he responded hissing in my face “You cannot dare take me down to the floor in front of all and win...”.

The 1980 Czechoslovak Championship in Prague was very successful for the TJ SPOJE BRATISLAVA club – it won 16 of 25 medals. We had extraordinary athletes at that time. But what was going on backstage? František Šebej, the chief referee, had no authority to act as a referee in the rink – under the effective rules he could only coordinate the referee team. When I was there to start the final karate contest against Laco Klementis (his friend), Šebej pushed the referee out of the rink and was ready to act as referee for that competition.

Why? He wanted his friend to win. He is the very same František Šebej who now is a member of the Slovak parliament. And earlier, in 1980 at the Barcelona European Championship, Šebej and Peter Vavro were the managers of the Czechoslovak representation whose responsibilities included giving 7 o’clock wake-up calls to athletes. My competition was scheduled for Sunday but they did not wake me up. “Why?” I asked. “Well, we spent the night with ballet dancers from Brno” was the response by František Šebej. NO COMMENT.

The Czechoslovak league championship was held in 1982: the TJ SPOJE BRATISLAVA team was fighting the TJ Ekonóm Bratislava team, hoping to get into the best five. Ladislav Klementis whispered something in the ear of Tibor Mikuš, the referee. Tibor Mikuš called me, as the captain of the TJ

(Takí jednoducho boli) Takže my sme boli diskvalifikovaní, nedali nám šancu zápasit'. Toto je pravdivý obraz zmanipulovaných víťazstiev v Československej lige.

Po tejto skúsenosti niektorí chlapci odišli z oddielu sklamaní, začali sa túlať po podnikoch, stali sa z nich bitkári....d'akujeme Ti Tibor Mikuš....a potom sa pripojili sa k Devínskej N. Vsi.....ja som tak isto rozmýšľal o odchode z karate... a časom po tejto skúsenosti som zanevrel na karate na Slovensku a trénoval len pozvoľna.

Trénoval som osobne od roku 1972 pod vedením Tibora, bolo tam veľa nádejných pretekárov aj zo zahraničia (študenti). Uvediem dva konkrétne prípady. Zahraničnému študentovi sa podarilo na tréningu kopom tobi yoko keru zasiahnuť Tibora do hrude, čo v zápase by znamenalo ippon, kde na tréningu tréner mal pochváliť cvičenca a viesť ho k jeho ďalšiemu rozvoju....čo spravil Tibor Mikuš ?...”dorasoval” ho pred

SPOJE team, and told the boys to take off their Dan 1 belts. “You can keep yours”, he said to me, “you were awarded your belt by Takeji Ogawa (1980). When I wanted to know why the others were supposed to take their belts off he answered: “We did not award their ranking belts to them.” (They had acquired their belts from the association that was duly authorized and the boys had earned them). They wanted to show the younger boys (18 and 19 year-olds) how important they were and also to keep our boys out of the competitions just so they could not win and become the champions of the Czechoslovak League. (That's what they were like.) We were disqualified and had no chance to prove our skills. This is the true picture of manipulated victories in the Czechoslovak League.

Some of the boys were very disappointed, left the club, started visiting bars, became rioters ... thank you, Tibor Mikuš....and then they joined the Devínska Nova Ves team. I was also considering leaving karate for good. I was embittered from that experience in Slovak karate and my trainings were somewhat poor as my trainings were guided by Tibor after 1972.

There were many promising athletes, including students from abroad. I will mention two examples. An international student succeeded in hitting Tibor's chest with a tobi yoko keru kick at a training, which would be an ippon in an official competition. One would expect the trainer to praise the athlete and further guide and develop him. What was the response from Tibor Mikuš? His ego could not stand that a student had done that to him so he gave the student a rough lesson in front of the other boys. The international student never came back.

Podobný prípad sa stal Jarovi Juhásovi, keď podobne úderom gyako zuki dal najavo, že je učenív, ale nemal to robiť na tréningu u Tibora...zlomil mu potom dve rebrá, aby ukázal, čo si môžu cvičenci dovoliť u neho na tréningu...takí boli...mňa osobne vyhodil z A-čka do B-čka z dôvodu, že som neprišiel na tréning, lebo som musel ísť fotiť (bol to môj koníček aj obživa) a on si nedal nič vysvetliť, lebo on je Tibor..., samozrejme, za približne mesiac prišiel s prosíkom, aby som sa vrátil do A-čka...

1996 založili sme s Emilom Kocianom karate klub KOCIAN -MÝTNY zaregistrovaný na MV Slovenskej republiky. Zostavili sme družstvo z našich aj starších žiakov a hneď prvý rok sme skončili na Majstrovstvách Slovenska v Trenčíne v družstvách na tret'om mieste a tým sme si vybojovali aj postup na ME (vid'. foto). Zavítali sme ešte v tom roku aj do Trnavy na vianočný turnaj (čo som nemal robiť). Chlapci v jednotlivcoch postupovali dobre a získali aj nejakú tú medailu, ale.....keď sme mali zápasit' v družstvách prišli za mnou organizátori, že máme ísť zápasit'. Ja hovorím, že však nič nehlásili....a oni - Karate klub KOCIAN - MÝTNY nebudeme vyhlasovať....prečo však bol zaregistrovaný na MV oficiálne, alebo v Trnave nezniesli, že tam nie je Tiborove meno a odvtedy som zanevrel definitívne na karate... d'akujem Ti Tibor Mikuš...!!!

Jaro Juhás experienced something similar after he had employed a gyako zuki and, having shown that he was quick to learn. He made a mistake – he should not have done that in a training conducted by Tibor. Jaro ended up with two broken ribs as a result of the lesson on what students are allowed to do in Tibor's trainings. That is how they behaved. Tibor demoted me from A group to B group just because I missed a training. I had to work as a photographer during that training time as photography was both my hobby and my breadwinning activity. Tibor just would not accept any apology. A month later, however, he begged me to come back to the A group.

Emil Kocian and I started the KOCIAN-MÝTNY Karate Club, registered with the Interior Ministry in 1996. We put together a team of our senior students and the very first year we ranked third in the team competition at the Slovak Championship in Trenčín and we would be able to participate in the European Championship (see photo). That year we also went to Trnava to its regular Christmas tournament but we should not have done that. Our boys were doing well in the singles competition and harvested a couple medals. When the time came for teams, the organizers told me to engage the boys for combat. I commented that there was no announcement made of our team engaging in competition. They responded that there would be no announcements for Karate Club KOCIAN-MÝTNY. I just could not understand. The club was officially registered with the Interior Ministry. Perhaps in Trnava they could not stand that Tibor's name was not there. I definitely got upset about karate – thanks to you, Tibor Mikuš!!!

May 14, 2010 celebrated 30 years of successful Slovak karate (???). The gala evening was held under the auspices of Tibor Mikuš, a member of the Slovak parliament and head of the Trnava Self-Governing Region. There were photographs in posters that violated copyrights. Is that proper? A member of parliament is allowed to do anything – including stealing? You really don't have the money, Tibor? I asked you three times (including in writing) to settle the copyright claims. There has never been a response. Perhaps that is what certain people deem to be in accordance with good morals. Is that right Tibor?

You destroyed numerous talents for the sake of your ego. I stopped training because of you and now I have stopped taking pictures of karate particularly in Trnava, pending your settlement of copyright claims for pictures of the 1980 Barcelona European Championship which you have used for your own promotion.
